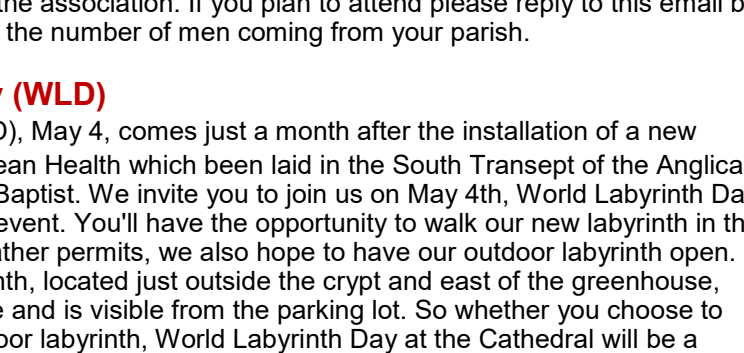
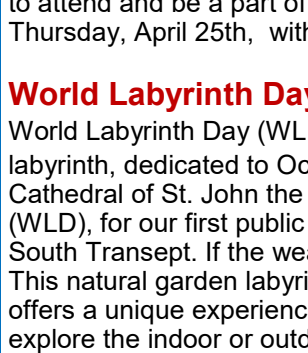

This marks the **first Synod of Bishops at which women are present and included as voting members.**

- Her experience in Rome,
- The fruits of the session in October 2023
- Her experience of meetings with diverse groups since that event,
- And her expectations of the event at the second session in October 2024.

She will also seek wisdom from the participants on ways of creating an inclusive church which works with other churches and faith traditions to shape a more just and peaceful world - a key theme of living a synodal Church in mission.

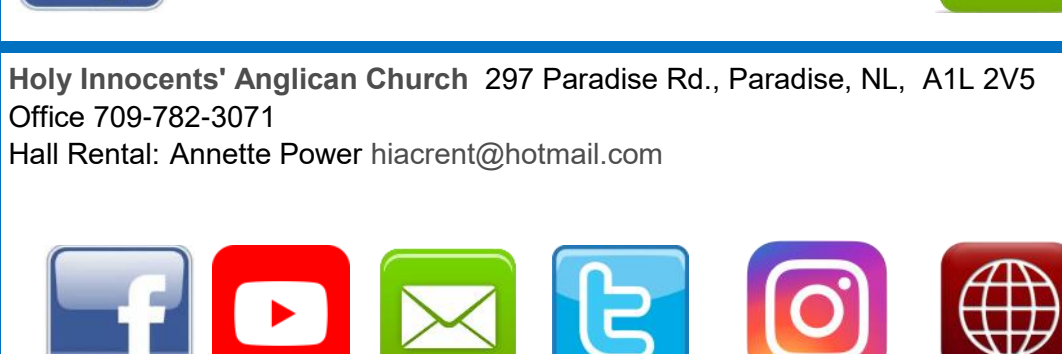
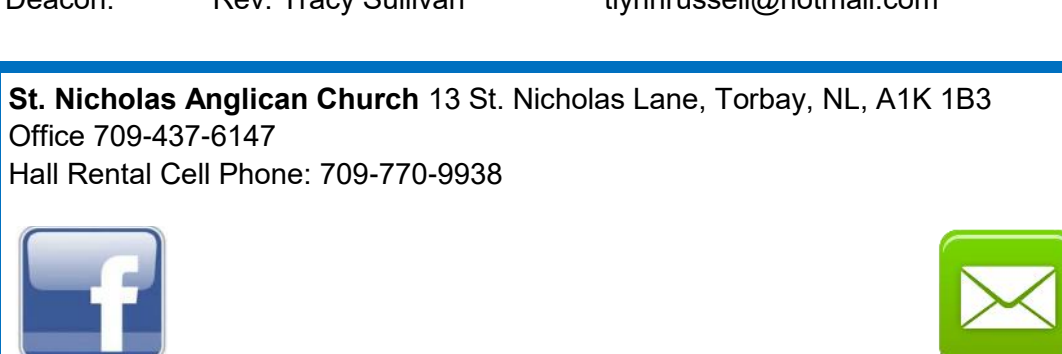
